

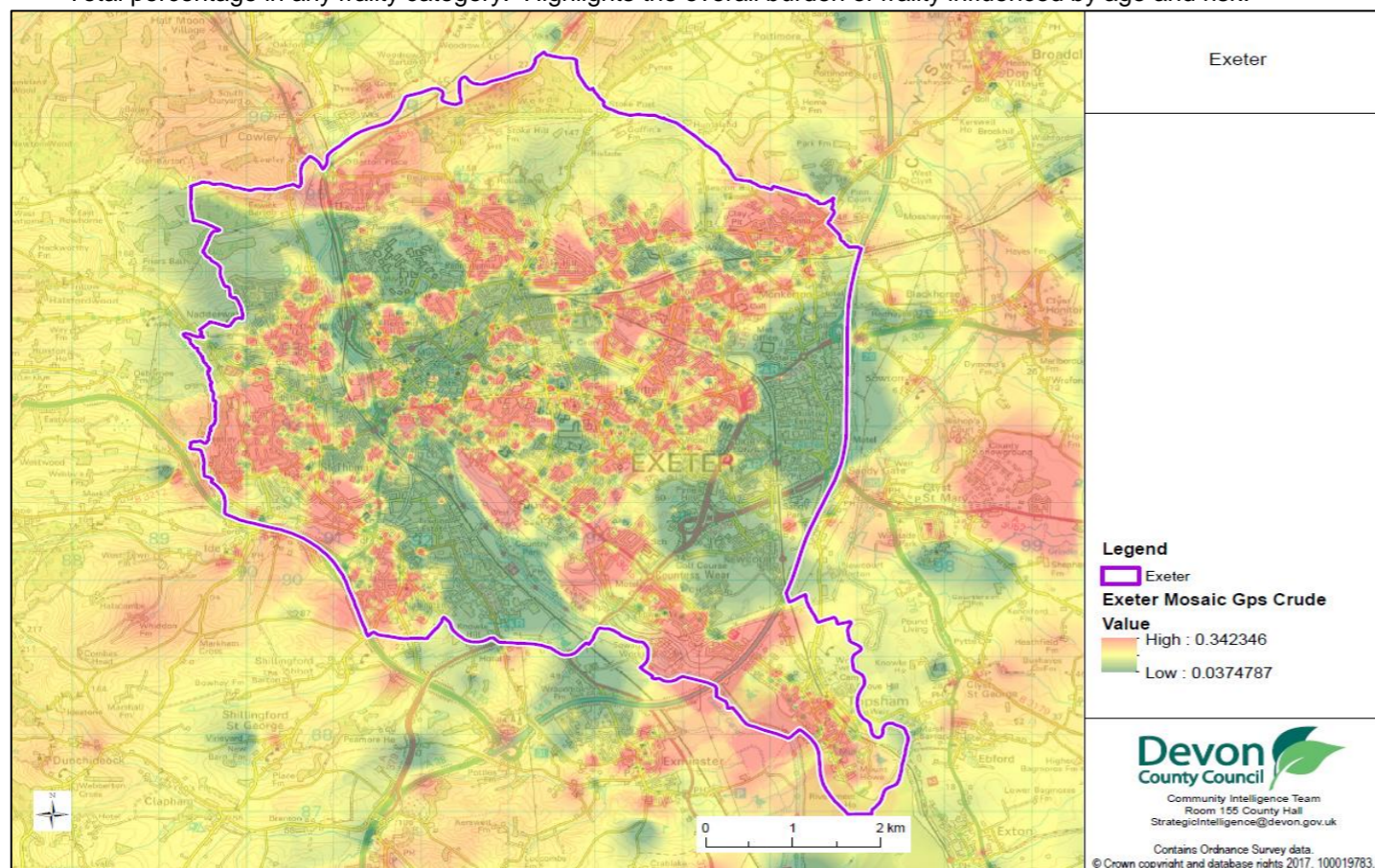

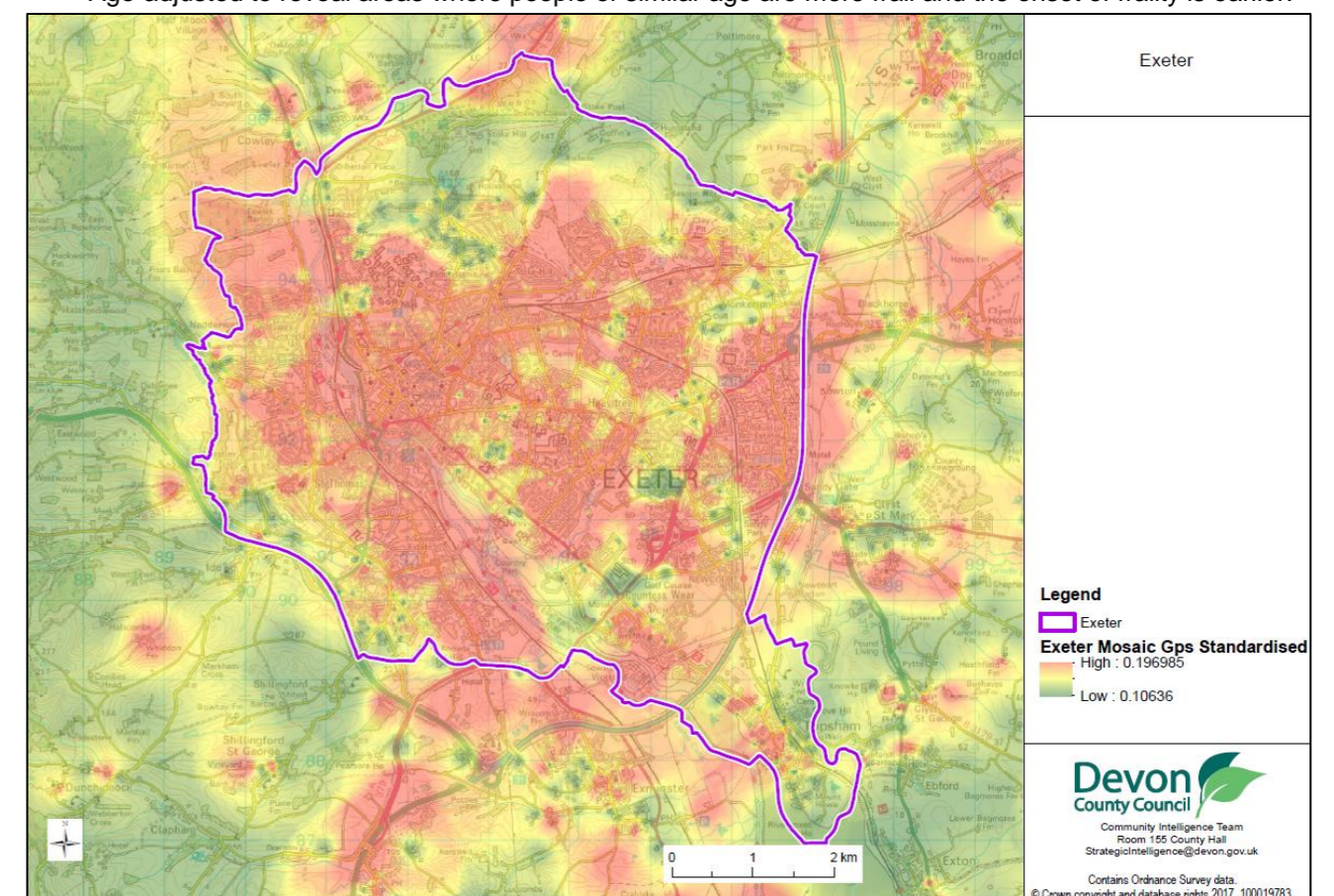
Mosaic Frailty Hotspot Mapping: Crude Percentage

Mosaic Frailty Hotspot Mapping: Standardised Percentage

Age-adjusted to reveal areas where people of similar age are more frail and the onset of frailty is earlier.
